

If you'd like, you can also share files with your tutor. Upload your homework or reading worksheet-or whatever you're working on. You and your tutor will be able to look at your work together in the classroom.



Step 4: Start your session

Click on the CONNECT NOW button to quickly connect with an incredible tutor.

Classroom sessions are recorded so that you can look at them later if you need help remembering something your tutor said.

Step 5: Rate and review your session

After each session, be sure to let us know how we did! You'll also be able to play a recording of your session and email or print the text-chat and whiteboards.

Once you finish rating and reviewing your session, simply close the Tutor.com window.




ENVIRONMENT
