Academic Discourse

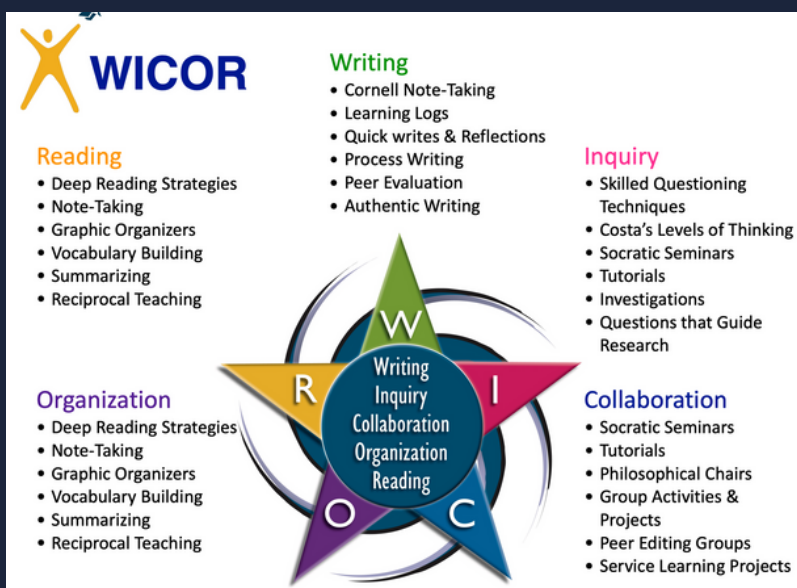

Evidence of Lesson Planning

What is Evidence of Lesson Planning?
Students should be able to articulate..

- What are students learning?
- How will students learn it?
- How will students be assessed?
- Why are students learning it?

When expressing "how will students be learning it," be explicit with students about which strategies they'll be using. The strategy serves as a scaffold to content and also as a scaffold to language for those students who need it. Once a student discovers what works best for them, they will begin to naturally utilize the strategy as a tool for learning. At that point, students have agency over their own learning. That is our end goal, students who can self-regulate their learning and take ownership over their learning.


Tiered Interventions:

Tiered academic interventions are coming soon.

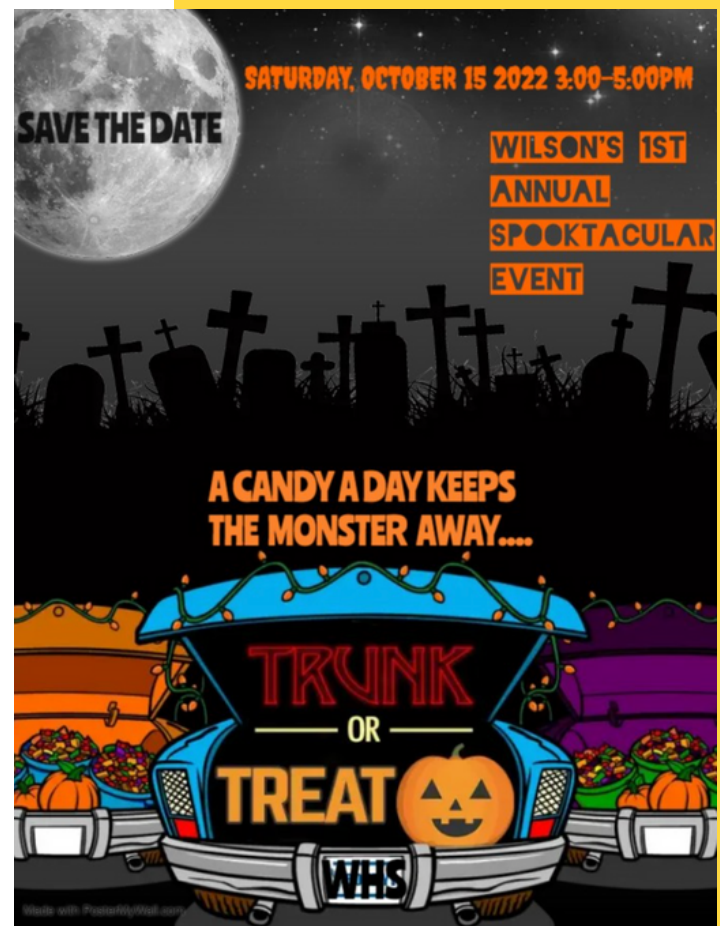
