

Dear Wilson HS Family,



ACADEMICS & ATTENDANCE

Attendance Update





On October 28th we celebrated the 50th day of the school year. This day gave us an opportunity to reflect on our attendance rate. 30% of students have a minimum of 3 absences. That puts them in the red band. The goal by the end of the year is for fewer than 19% of students to be in the red band "chronically absent." We continue to work with students and families to eliminate barriers to daily school attendance.

Last week we launched the next phase in our PD plan: Writing. While "writing" has been a focus in our instruction, the type of writing most prominently highlighted in our PD plan has been "Learning Through Writing." Now we take the next step, helping students "Learn to Write" in all content areas!. Literacy is a school-wide effort.
