Reflective

We thoughtfully consider the world and our own ideas and experience. We work to understand our strengths and weaknesses in order to support our learning and personal development.

The IB Learner Profile attribute of the month is Reflective. This attribute perhaps has greater significance to our work as educators more than the others. Learning is a product of reflection and self-examination. Without reflection we often fail to reach deeper levels of understanding. Without introspection and self-reflection we fail to understand ourselves, to reach mastery or ownership of our own thinking, perspectives, beliefs and values.

Reflection is tied to a Growth Mindset.
