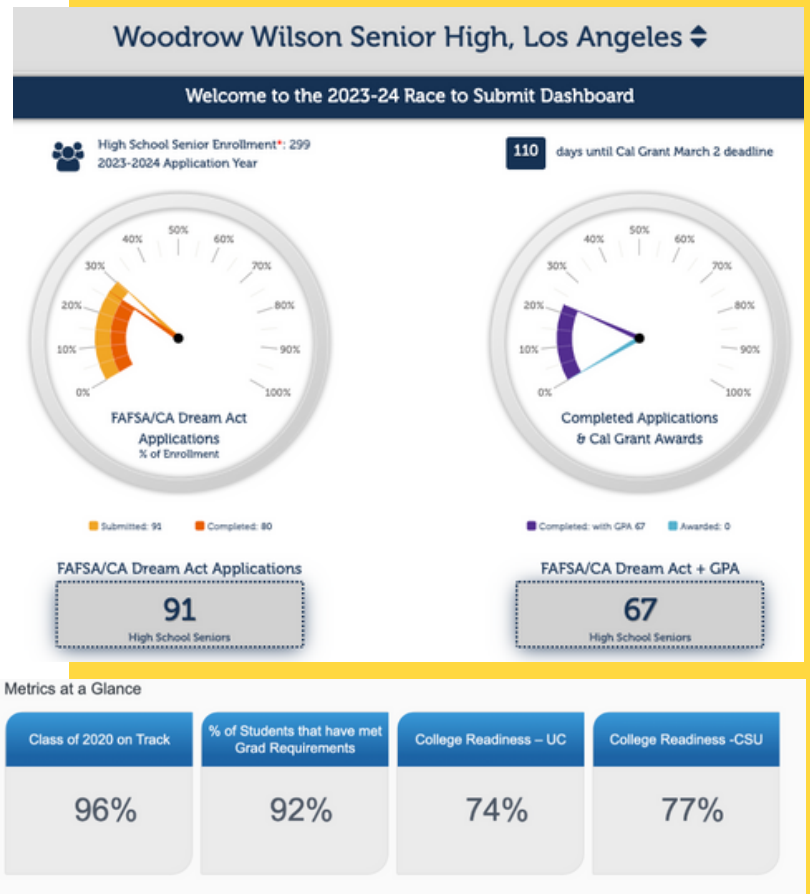

Class of 2023 – Breaking Records

The Class of 2023 is off to an amazing start. Nearly **30%** of all seniors have completed their FAFSA applications. Thank you to **Team College** and the **12th grade Social Studies teachers** who are supporting by tacking students' progress.

Also, our Class of 2023, leads the way for the entire Local District East with **96%** of all seniors on track to graduation, with **92%** having met all Grad Requirements and **74% and 76%** meeting the UC and CSU requirements, respectively. These numbers have never been seen this early in the school year. Team work is making the dream work!
